

## WNBC Meeting Minutes 1/12/10

4. We will be ordering 10 pizzas for the boys' basketball games. Seem to have a bigger turn-out and sell more pizza.
5. Andrea and Linda came up with a check-off list for closing procedures. This should eliminate any problems when closing the stand.
6. Transportation department was contacted once again for the \$150 they owe us back from the bus rodeo.
7. Winter Bazaar sold about \$300 worth of Spirit wear, cheerleaders helped sell that day. 8<sup>th</sup> grade night sold \$175, need more stock including duffle bags. Car decals were ordered, will sell for \$5.
8. We are continuing to offer Thunderwear Thursdays. It was suggested to put samples of spirit wear with order forms so kids can pre-order and pick up the following week. Maybe use the cases near/in the cafeteria.
9. We will donate ½ of the cost of the bowling shirts for the Co-op teams.
10. 50/50 raffle is going to stay with Booster Club. It will only be done at higher attendance games. Patti Baltes will run utilizing the key club members.
11. Casino night possibility, different options were discussed. Mike will get more info. Out via e-mail to the club.
12. Golf outing-Pete is getting quotes from different courses. Date has yet to be determined.
13. Nick gave us a cost of \$3660 for the Conference banners for the gym. He is shooting for late spring early summer so we can get them put up. He also discussed the Buffalo Wild Wings fundraiser. 15% of food bill is donated back to the school. Our first date is January 28<sup>th</sup>. There are 8 schools competing and the school that brings in the most money wins \$3,000 for their athletic program.
14. Vote was taken to put \$3,000 aside for the wrestling matt stand. Nick to contact Coach Gutteridge to find out how much the team fundraised that they could contribute to the cost.
