Meeting Minutes  
August 4, 2009

1. July 2<sup>nd</sup> minutes were accepted.

9. Board decided to have coaches put in their requests at the beginning of our meeting, that way they don't need to stay for the whole meeting. At the end of the meeting we will take a vote on the request and then notify them to the outcome.
10. Mary suggested putting out a questionnaire asking parents who they work for and if their business is able to support us in any way. All agreed it was a good idea.
11. We will be using the outdoor stand at the Blue/Teal game on August 21<sup>st</sup>. Sophomore at 6:00 and Varsity at 7:00.
12. We decided to order 50 car flags as well as 50 cushioned seats. Karen to check into Halo to see if better prices are available.
