3. We are looking to hold a Candlelight Bowl to be held on November 8th at Kingston Lanes. There are 20 lanes and he would charge us \$10.00 per couple. We are still working out the details in regards to food for the evening.
4. Golf outing Gary/Phil are looking into some options for which course to go with. We would like to keep it at a cost of \$100. Also, would like to have raffle tickets out by October 1st in order to get fall sports athletes involved in selling tickets.
5. We will be voting at end of meeting on the updated by-laws.
6. We are in good shape financially.
7. Tami is working on getting more family/parent memberships. She will be setting up a table outside of the gate to try to get more memberships. She is getting more information from the Independent they are interested in a banner. Tami also suggested trying to come up with some ideas of how to get memberships sooner. Maybe offer an incentive to renew early.
8. New spirit wear is selling well. We are selling last year's items at a discount. We are going to sell t-shirts for the cross-town game. They will start selling them the Monday prior. Waiting on the proofs from the Locker Shop.
9. Concessions: New items are selling well. We sold out of pretzels. Root beer floats sold really well. Phil will move freezer from trailer to accommodate the frozen items. Items to be sold at the trailer: Drinks, Dogs, Burgers, chips and candy. The plan is to close after half-time of the varsity game.
10. Dolphins swim meet December 7-8th.
11. Voted to approve Scoops running concessions for conference cross country we will get 20% of the profits.
12. We voted unanimously to rent a generator for the trailer for football games.
13. Voted unanimously to hold a Candlelight bowl fundraiser on November 8th.
14. Our updated By-Laws were approved and will be on the web-site.
15. There is a link on our web-site as well as the athletic site to our spirit wear on-line store.
