

## **Woodstock North High School**

### **Booster Club Meeting Minutes**

**August 4, 2016**

Guest Presentation: Matthew Haynes

Meeting called to order at 5:15 p.m.

1. M. Haynes (WNHS Senior) presented overview of his current Eagle Scout (Troop 159) project; building 6 permanent recycling containers to be used at WNHS. WNHS does not have any containers. This project lends itself as a benefit to future athletes, the school and the environment. Haynes completed his overview with the need for these items and the remaining balance to finish project. He has raised all but \$230.00 of the total \$1,220.00 to complete it. He requested the Booster committee to consider donating the \$230.00 balance for him to complete this project. Vote was taken at the end of the meeting and it passed unanimously to donate \$230.00.
2. Discussion to set dates for coaches requests for upcoming seasons. Fall season and Winter season requests are due by Booster meeting on September 1, 2016. Determined that there will be last minute exception requests and a form will need to be completed and submitted for those to be considered. Coaches requests for Spring season is due by the Booster meeting on January 5, 2017. Next school year, Fall season requests will be due sooner on yet to be determined Booster meeting date.
3. No Athletic Director report this evening. Athlete player/parent meeting to be held immediately following this meeting.
4. Account balance status is improved from this time last year due to less donation made to school this past year. Balance of \$9,947.00 to date. Summer 2016 events (baseball and swimming tournaments) helped to increase balance. \$2,000.00 profit from each event. Thermometer tracking needs to be updated; \$174,00.00 donated by WNHS Booster organization to date. Decision made by committee to dispense a donation check to Woodstock Dolphins.
5. Members will disperse to breakout rooms after meeting with volunteer sign-up sheets for the concession season coming up. Obtain a parent volunteer for each team to act as a liaison between team parents and concession coordinator, Lagerstrom. Lagerstrom requested another person to assist her with concession coordination for the 2016 - 17 school year. Senn, Zinnen, Lagerstrom met previously and decided there will need to be 2 volunteers working the

concession stand for volleyball games and 6 volunteers for football games. Senn recommended purchase of one large propane tank to replace numerous smaller ones currently in use. Cost saving and efficiency sighted. Dog pen has been offered for donation to use as a garbage container collection area. Use approval to be sought by District Administration. Banner placement on Concession building wall discussed to be used to promote Crosstown Challenge event.

6. Crosstown tickets to be ordered August 5, 2016. Sponsors continue to come in for event. Volunteer signup sheets for event to be created and used in conjunction with WHS Backers committee. Woodstock Independent account balance to be used for ad promotion of the Crosstown Challenge event. Napoli's, Offsides to promote event on/at their businesses. Proof to Backer's of the event t-shirt for their approval. More details to be addressed at next Booster/Backers meeting on August 22, 2016.
7. Orders for spirit wear are being made. Waiting for product samples first. Working to design sweatpants, Varsity shirts, tank tops, etc. Stadium seats appear to be costly to order. Decision made to order 10 and see how sales/rental goes. Hand warmers order to be placed. On-line store to be setup. \$331.40 deficit in account to start out 2016-17 year. Decision made to begin this season's ordering with \$1,600.00.
8. Other - WNHS football fundraiser to be held and approval of request for \$50.00 spirit wear gift certificate to be given as raffle prize.
