Booster Club Meeting Minutes

October 4, 2016

Meeting called to order at 6:05 p.m.

1. Coach request presented by Varsity Head Basketball Coach Steve Ryan. Request made for 40 reversible jerseys and 20 travel backpacks both with numbers and logos. Pricing comparisons made by coach. A total of \$1,685.00 (lowest bid vendor) for all items was voted on and approved by the board. R. Haynes motion, C. Patenaude seconded and vote carried.
2. Athletic Director Report: Upcoming IHSA events to be hosted at WNHS discussed; Cross Country Regional 10/22/16, Soccer Regional 10/18, 10/19, 10/22 and Volleyball Regional 10/24 - 10/27 (specific dates for vb to be determined). Concession and volunteer needs discussed. State Tournaments possible for tennis, girl's golf and football with confirmation of qualifiers yet to be made. Board voted to present each qualified athlete/coach a \$25.00 stipend for food costs and to pay cost of hotel rooms while on the road to tournaments. Motion passed. Winter sports night to be determined, most likely 10/25/16.
3. Treasurer's Report: A balance of \$9,525.00 is recorded. Anticipated \$12,000 - \$15,000.00 profit to come from Cross-town Challenge game on 10/14/16.
4. Concession Report: 9 volunteers needed for the upcoming Freshman football game on 10/7/16. Usual means of recruiting volunteers has been done. Another request will be sent out to coaches by A.D. encouraging athletes/parents to sign on. Some volunteer volume for upcoming 10/14 & 10/22 games, need more. Cross-town discussion with regard to S. Dycus to manage concession area for 2016-17 season. Decision to be brought to S. Lagenstrom.
4. Spirit Wear Report: Coordinator/volunteer to be available at parent/teacher conferences to sell Cross-town Challenge t-shirts. Coverage for upcoming games for spirit wear sales is confirmed. Sales of Cross-town Challenge t-shirts remain strong, anticipate to sell remainder of shirts.
5. Cross-town Challenge Discussion: Memento footballs will be purchased and presented to sponsors. First National Bank volunteers will be at sponsor/volunteer sign-in with Booster/Backers member. All other FNB volunteers will be floaters and placed where needs arise. Volunteer sign-up sheets continue to be monitored as the need for more volunteers remains.
