Booster Club Meeting Minutes

December 1, 2016

Meeting called to order at 6:00 p.m.

1. A vote was taken on the coaches' request presentation from last month. Coaches from softball and baseball presented a request for a windscreen and a roof. Board voted unanimously to approve the request. The coaches will be given \$2,500.00
2. There was no Athletic Director (A.D.) report.
3. Treasurer's report: The current balance is \$15,602.00. There is approximately \$12,400.00 coming from the Crosstown Challenge proceeds. We are in a considerably stronger financial position than compared to last year at this time.
4. An on-line spirit wear store will be up and running next week. This will be run by R&S who will sell items and cut a monthly commission check to the Boosters (BC). This arrangement will make is easier and more manageable for the committee members. There is a large volume of inventory however committee members are confident it will sell all the way into fall of 2017. There will still be someone at some of the games to sell spirit wear.
5. Concession update: Again the numbers of volunteers is low. A.D. and Board President discussed having winter athletes volunteer one shift a piece (one that does not interfere with their team schedule). This most likely will happen. Coaches need to announce this to their athletes. Email requests for volunteers went largely unanswered. There is an overflow of some concession items and they are being sold to the Northwood Middle School PTO.
6. Other discussion: Wrestling asked to have the BC support the selling of sandwich meals at the WNHS Regional meet on December 10. After discussion, it was decided that the BC would not purchase any items and that wrestling representative would use the team's activity fund to purchase the meals. They will sell beginning at 6:30 a.m. at the meet and the BC concession stand will open at 9:00 a.m. 2017 golf outing will be addressed at the January BC meeting. There appears to be interest in holding it again using the same simpler format as last year. New BC member is Chris Maldonado. Welcome Chris!
7. Meeting adjourned at 7:05p.m.
