

WNHS Athletic Booster Club Meeting Minutes

November 5, 2015

Meeting called to order at 6:10 p.m.

In attendance at the meeting: Phil Senn, Rich Haynes, Tami Zinnen, Linda Miceli, Cristina Mazzanti, Katie Labude and Brady Stromquist.

Brady Stromquist presented a request for funds for a program titled Habitudes for Athletes. This is a program he would like to start at North, designed to bring students together in the areas of self leadership, teamwork, connecting with teammates, etc. He will have a team of athletic leaders, based on coaches recommendations, with the goal of forming an advisory committee for students- gathering student input, ideas, suggestions, etc. He received a grant from the Education Foundation in the amount of \$725. The amount he is requesting for the program is \$1,275. The board voted to APPROVE funding this request in the amount of \$1,275. (Karen – I will give you a copy of the request)

Brady Stromquist presented a request for funds for the baseball and softball fields. The requested amount is \$419.10. This amount would assist with purchasing wood and stone for additional pitching stations between fields, as well as repairing the track around the outfields. The work will be completed by the District Buildings and Grounds and the remainder of the materials would be paid for by the softball program. The board voted to APPROVE funding this request in the amount of \$419.10. (Karen – I will give you a copy of the request)

Cristina Mazzanti spoke on behalf of the wrestling program, requesting funds for painting the wrestling room walls, having inspirational sayings adhered to the wall, state qualifier names, etc. She stated she would do the painting, etc. Brady Stromquist explained that the work would need to be approved by Ken Roiland and completed by Buildings and Grounds Department by way of a work order. Brady Stromquist indicated that he would talk to Ken Roiland for permission to proceed with ideas. Brady also commented that the room is used for more than the wrestling program. Phil Senn asked if she had a designated amount for the request and she did not. She was instructed to obtain permission for the project, discuss the ideas with the coach and then come back to the booster club for assistance.

Cristina Mazzanti also spoke about concessions at the upcoming wrestling tournament. The wrestling moms would like to sell breakfast items from 6:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. It was determined that the wrestling program will receive 50% of the proceeds during this time. After 9:00 a.m., the concession stand will be run by the boosters.

Phil Senn stated that with the resignation of Kim Niese, we are in need of a new concession member. For the remainder of the year, Phil will oversee concessions and all of the booster members will contribute to the smooth running of the stand. Phil is working on a binder for the new concession member. It was discussed to open up this position to more than one person due all of the details and steps involved.

Cristina Mazzanti and Linda Miceli spoke briefly about the spiritwear. They showed a new hoodie that will be for sale immediately. Linda will be ordering more stocking caps as the weather is turning colder. There will be a couple dates scheduled for spiritwear to be sold during lunch. Cristina Mazzanti will

schedule workers (with the help of Katie Labude). Phil asked for a “cheap” tshirt to be purchased that will be shot out of the cannons at home games – we will use the remainder of the crosstown shirts before we purchase new shirts.

The senior banquet is scheduled for Wednesday, May 11th. Save the date flyers will be sent out to senior athletes, Tami will hand out to senior football players at the banquet next week. Tami will make the save the date cards and the invitations. A sample will be sent to the board members by the end of next week.

The golf outing will be held the first weekend of June. Tami will make tickets for the outing and have available at our December booster meeting.

Rich Haynes will purchase a tv to raffle during basketball/volleyball/wrestling season. The winning ticket will be drawn at the last home basketball game.

Brady Stromquist has an administrators meeting on Monday, at which time he will get approval and secure a date for the Donkey Basketball fundraiser. More details will coming.
