Booster Club Meeting Minutes
December 7, 2017

Meeting called to order at 6:00 p.m.

- 1. Coaches' requests:** Track coach Cagle requested additional warm-ups at a cost just under \$100.00 each. This would bring the total warm-ups the Booster has helped to fund to 24 sets. Vote at the end of the meeting. Physical Trainer Heldt requested an ATC - Hydroculator, essentially a heat pack unit. The original unit does not work and has been here since the H.S. opened. This unit would be larger because it is used every day and it is part of the regular trainers use. PT has raised the \$893.00 which is half the cost of a new one. Vote at the end of the meeting. Football coach Schroeder requested 75 Varsity pairs of pants, 6 helmets plus 3 free with the order. Football team has had same uniforms since WNHS opened.
- 2. Athletic Director (A.D.) report:** Girls/Boys Sectional host dates to be confirmed. Graphics on the scorer's table are requested and images to be included are Booster info, volunteer request, join and get involved, Booster/Athletic websites. Video is possible in the future. KRC Cheer Dance competition on 1/17/18. 11 teams, WNHS to host every other year. Booster fundraiser 1/20/18 use athletic and Booster website to increase traffic, coordinate with G. Darling. 2-3 raffle items for Booster member, flyers to be created, promotion to begin at Wrestling tournament. Relay for Life will be in June. Girls Track Sectional WNHS host possibility. Touch Pro arrived and is to be mounted over the holiday break.
- 3. Treasurer's report:** The current balance is \$24,050.00 with \$13,000.00 to be added when the check is presented at the Crosstown Basketball game in February.
- 4. Spirit wear report:** Promo items as holiday gifts through R&S, WNHS morning announcements, flyers, on our website. Items and order forms to be available on 12/15/17 during lunch periods.
- 5. Concessions:** Volunteers continue to be a concern, with low numbers responding to volunteer in concessions. Will try new feature of the night food item, price to be determined. Announcements will be made that the stand is closing after the intermission.
- 6. Communications:** Bi-weekly Booster Bulletin with consistent updates to audiences, sample bulletin to be sent out for comments. Members page of Boosters to share documents, etc.
- 7. Other Discussion:** Crosstown Classic basketball game at WNHS, check presentation at that time. Hospitality room for sponsors will be provided, food menu to be ordered. Cross Country team won the team sales challenge. Communication with incoming 8th

graders to be improved. Various ideas of earlier distribution to students about high school options were discussed. Information packets to be created and distributed.

8. Voting: **Boy's Track** discussion made to provide 9 more warm up sets at approximately \$70.00 each. A total of \$2,703.00 has been given. Rich Haynes motioned for \$500.00 (promised prior) to the team plus an additional \$500.00 for a total of \$1,000.00 to the team and this is a non-negotiable total. Julie Brucher seconded, all in favor. Motion passed. **Physical Trainer hydroculator** discussion to fund the full amount at \$1,785.00 as PT have never requested from Boosters prior and she came with half the money raised. Those monies can be put toward other department needs. Motion to grant full amount to PT was made by Rich Haynes and seconded by Sarah Dycus. **Football** request for 75 Varsity pants and helmets at a cost of \$7,803.00 was discussed. Vicky Long motioned to grant full amount for football items, Chris Maldonado seconded and all voted in favor.

Meeting adjourned 8:22p.m.
